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more colors were used, and ukiyoe pictures became much more colorful. Ukiyoe was very popular at the end of the 18th century. However, in the late 19th century ukiyoe began to lose some of its popularity. However, around that time, ukiyoe was introduced to artists in the west. And once again this style of art became quite popular.

**Track 24: Integrated Listening**  
You've all read the article about Katsushika Hokusai and read about his life. An important moment in his life was when he was told to leave school. He was embarrassed by this and the experience made him work a lot harder. It was his inspiration to improve. Perhaps the most famous collection in the ukiyoe style of art is Hokusai's Thirty-Six Views of Mount Fuji. This series became so popular that he even added an extra ten prints later. Included in the Thirty-Six Views of Mount Fuji was The Great Wave off Kanagawa. The picture is actually a mix of Japanese and western styles. One of the colors used was a special color of blue that was imported from England. At that time, many Japanese people had probably never seen that color before. We can see Japan's interest in travel and other cultures in the picture. There may have been 5,000 – 8,000 prints made. Many copies are in museums and private collections around the world. However, some of these prints are still available to buy today. The painting is still very popular.

#### Unit 7 : Fish Farming

**Track 25: Main Listening**  
Fish farming, or aquaculture, is one of the world's fastest growing businesses. Now, perhaps we think of fish farming as being a new industry. However, in fact, fish farming has a long history. Fish farming began in China over 4,000 years ago. However in recent years the industry has been growing quickly. World aquaculture, the raising and harvesting fish, produces over 65 million tons of seafood a year and over 90% of fish farming is done in Asia. Today 50% of all seafood produced comes from farms. Many kinds of seafood are produced through aquaculture, for example seaweed, shrimp, salmon, trout, cod, oysters and so on. Because of this there are many different types of aquaculture. For example, pond farming is done inland. Often

shrimp or carp are produced this way, in large ponds inland, away from the ocean or lakes and rivers. Cage farming is different. Cage farming is done in the ocean, lakes and rivers. It is done in both fresh water and salt water. Cages, or a system of nets, hold the fish in. They are part of the environment. The cages allow the water to be continuously recycled and changed with water in the environment.

**Track 28: Integrated Listening**  
Sure, fish farming can be bad. And some fish farms can be very bad for the environment. However, it depends on what kinds of fish are being raised. Some fish farming is not so bad for the environment. For example, one fish that doesn't cause too many problems is the Tilapia. Tilapia are ideal for fish farming because they don't get stressed in crowded conditions, and therefore don't get sick as easily as other large farmed fish and therefore don't need hormones or antibiotics. In addition, tilapia do not eat other fish. They eat sea grasses and so on, and at fish farms they often eat corn or other vegetable products and so they are quite easy to raise. Seafood Watch, a consumer group that studies fish farming, says that Tilapia is a best choice when choosing farmed fish at the supermarket. In addition, international standards, or international rules on fish farming are now being developed. For example, in some countries there are new standards for fish farming that don't allow the use of antibiotics. So, basically, although the article is true, it is not the whole story.

#### Unit 8 : Time on Task

**Track 29: Main Listening**  
Time on task is an important concept for studying a foreign language. Time-on-task is the amount of time we spend doing something. You know, we often see businesses and schools advertising special methods to learn a language. "Learn faster with us" they say. However, the truth is, learning a language takes time. Put simply you need to actively use the language and actively study the language for thousands of hours. For example, let's look at the TOEIC test. TOEIC stands for Test of English for International Communication and it is a well known test. According to research, it takes 100 hours of study to reach a score of 300, which is actually quite low. To get a score of 700, an intermediate level,

it takes a thousand hours of study, or time-on-task. To get up to an advanced level, say 900 on the TOEIC, you need to have 1,800 hours of time-on-task. And, this 1,800 hours means that you need to be actively processing meaning for 1,800 hours. Time on task, is the time you spend actively processing meaning. So, if you spend time studying a foreign language by using your first language, for example, reading about the grammar of a foreign language in your own native language, this can not be called time on task, because you're actually processing your native language. To learn a foreign language, you need to be actively processing the foreign language.

**Track 32: Integrated Listening: Support**  
*Outlier*, was number one on the New York Times best-seller list. In his book, Gladwell gave many examples of his 10,000 hour rule. He found that many world-class athletes had practiced for 10,000 hours. He also researched world-class violin players and found that it usually took 10,000 hours of practice to become a top-class, elite violin player. However, he also found that violin players who practiced for 2,000 hours also became pretty good. These people didn't get to the very top, but they did get quite good and many became teachers. This is an example of the Pareto principle, which states that 20% of your effort will usually give you 80% of your result. And, there are many examples of this. Many businesses have found that 20% of their customers give them 80% of their business. Another example, although negative, is in health care. A study into hospital use found that 20% of patients used up 80% of the health care resources. So, think about how good you want to be. Think about the 10,000 hour rule and the Pareto principle, how many hours will it take to reach your goal.

#### Unit 9 : Sports Psychology

**Track 33: Main Listening**  
Sports psychology is a branch of psychology that looks at the psychology of sports. The first studies into sport psychology were done in the 1890's. An American man named Norman Triplett studied cyclists, uh, people who raced bicycles. And Triplett noticed that the race times improved when people were riding against other cyclists. This was the beginning of sports psychology. And recently sports psychology has become an

important field. Today, sports psychologists are used by many professional sports teams, to help their athletes improve their performance. There are two main types of sports psychologists, educational psychologists and clinical psychologists. Educational sports psychologists help athletes improve their performance, and clinical psychologists help athletes control their emotions. Educational sports psychologists teach athletes about psychological techniques to help the athletes improve their performance. For example, having clear goals can help an athlete improve. Talking to yourself has also been found to help with performance. These are just a few of the techniques that educational sports psychologists use. Clinical sports psychologists work with emotional issues, for example controlling feelings of anger or irritation. If an athlete gets angry, perhaps he or she can't think clearly. Clinical sports psychologists try to help athletes and coaches control their anger and in so doing, help them improve and be better athletes. Helping athletes with anger management is thus an important part of a clinical psychologist's job.

**Track 36: Integrated Listening**  
How can people achieve their exercise goals? Studies say that 30-35 minutes of simple exercise, like walking 3-5 times a week, is best to make people feel more positive. Of course many people say they don't have enough time to do this. A good way to start is by walking for just 10 minutes. People can try to include this in their daily activities, like walking to the shop. Then try to walk for longer periods. It's important to not try to do something too difficult. A lot of people try to exercise but give up soon because it's too hard. It's also a good idea to do exercise with a friend or other people. This increases motivation and enjoyment. Exercise can also help people to sleep, which is needed for maintaining good mental health. A study at Northwestern University found that regular exercise helped to improve the quality of sleep. Another study found that the risk of developing some mental illnesses can be reduced by 20 – 30% with exercise, that is, there is scientific evidence that in some cases exercise can reduce stress and mental illness.

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
